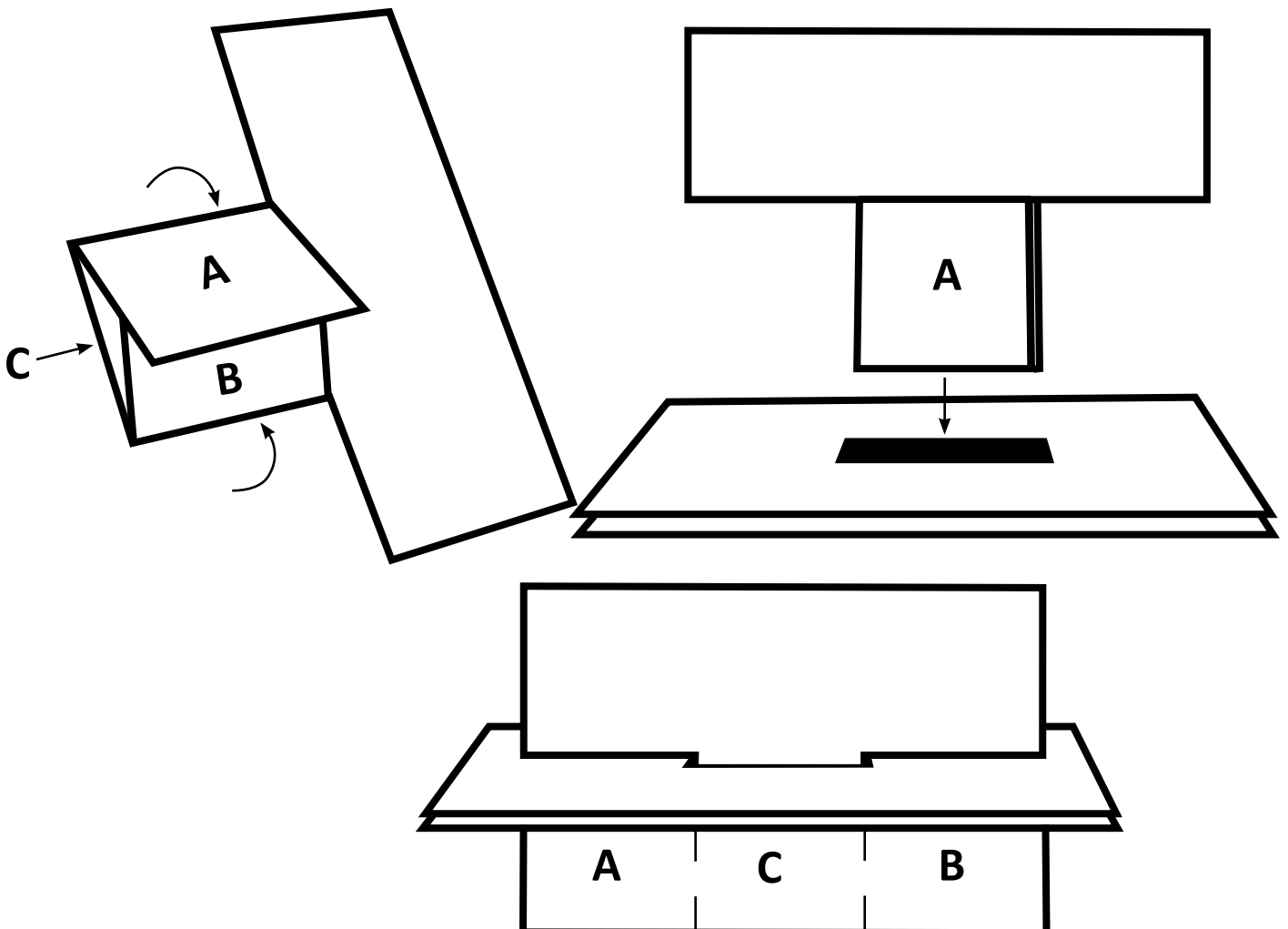
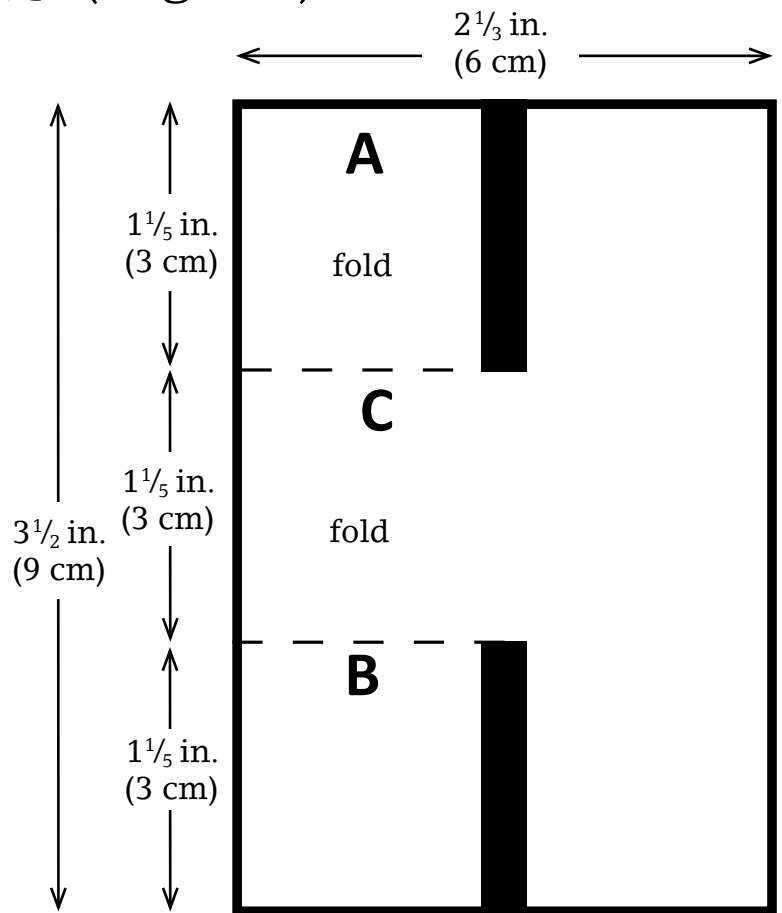
Cat Shapes



Cardboard Cat Den (Page 12)

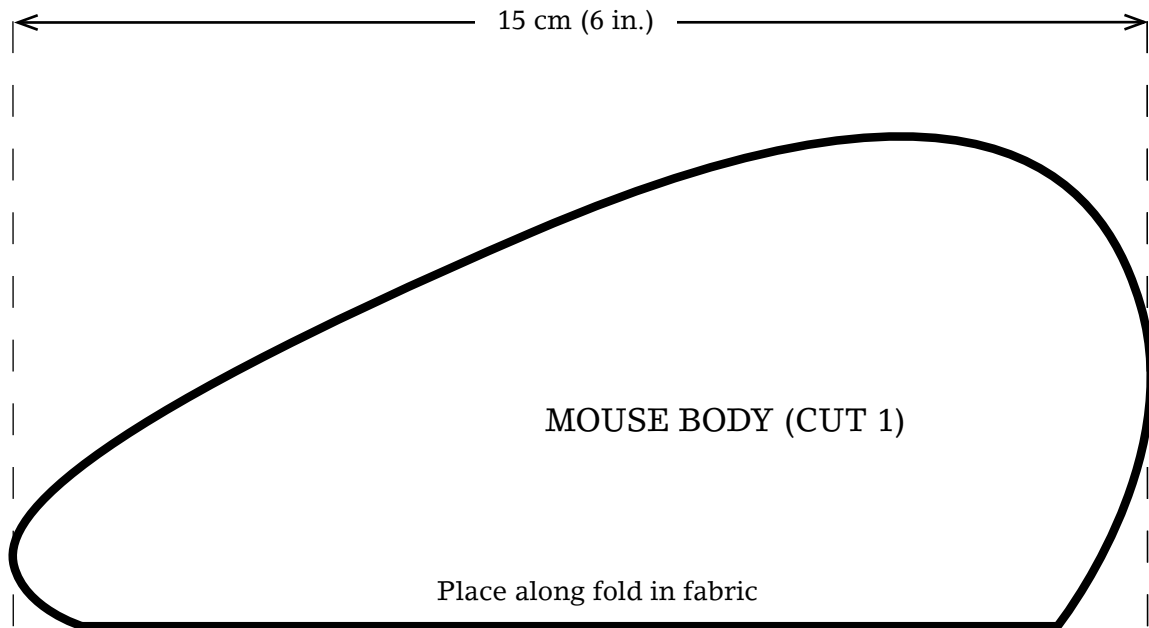
Cardboard fixing template for making your cardboard cat den.

- 1** Cut along the solid lines.
- 2** Fold along the dotted lines.
- 3** Cut a slot of 1 in. \times $\frac{1}{5}$ in. (3 cm \times 0.5 cm) in both pieces of card.
- 4** Fold in flaps A and B over C.
- 5** Push through slots and unfold.

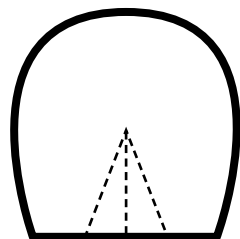


Mini Mouse (Page 20)

Fold the fabric in half and place the mouse body template with the base along the fold in the fabric.



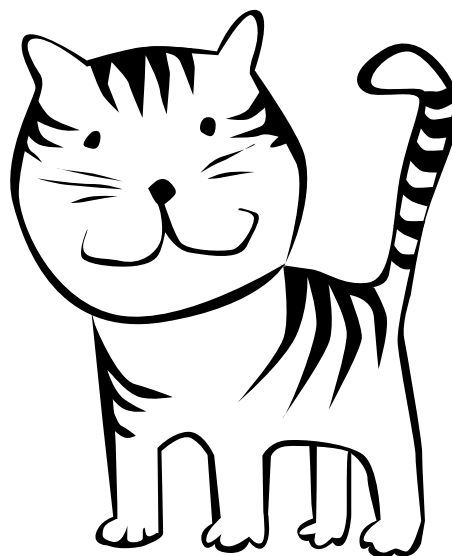
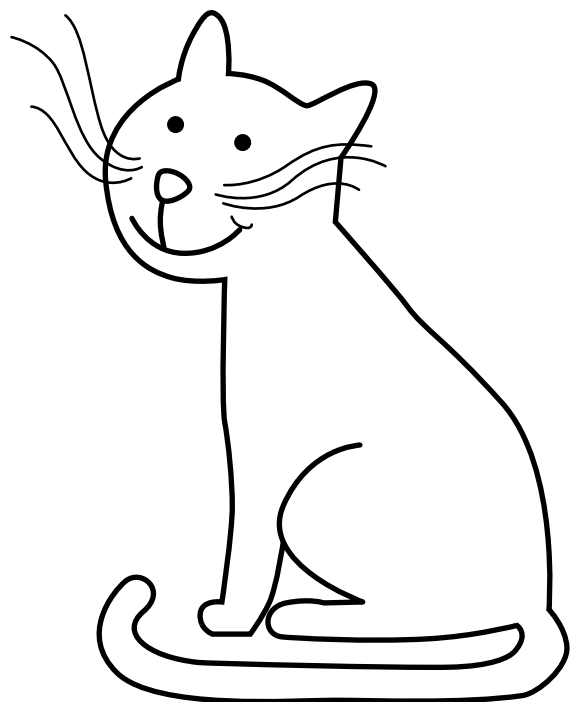
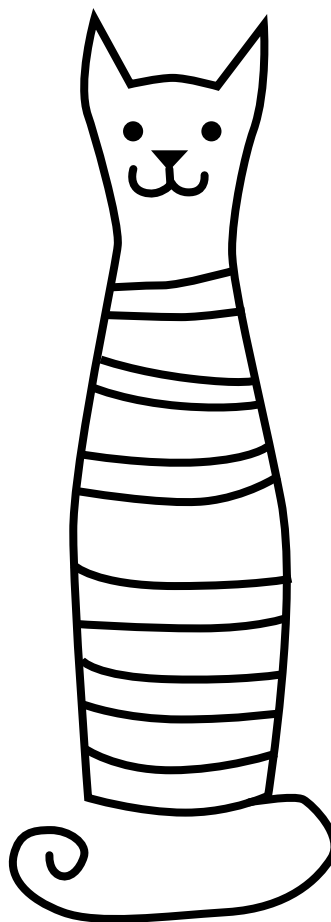
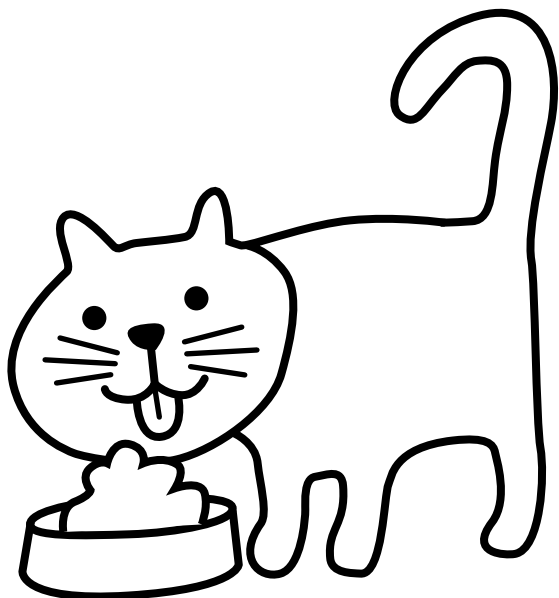
Cut 2 mouse ear templates and fold the fabric of the ear where shown before sewing.

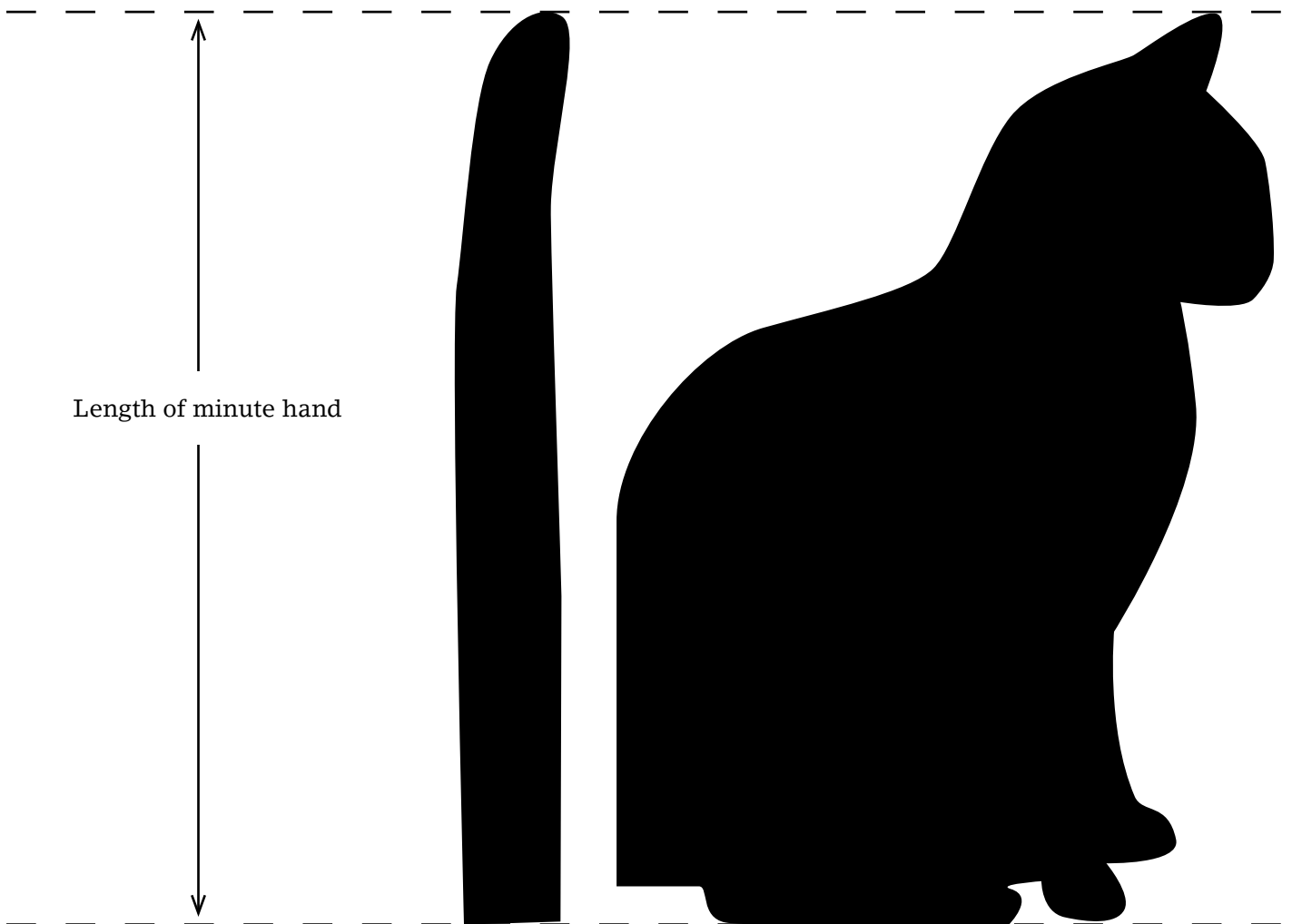
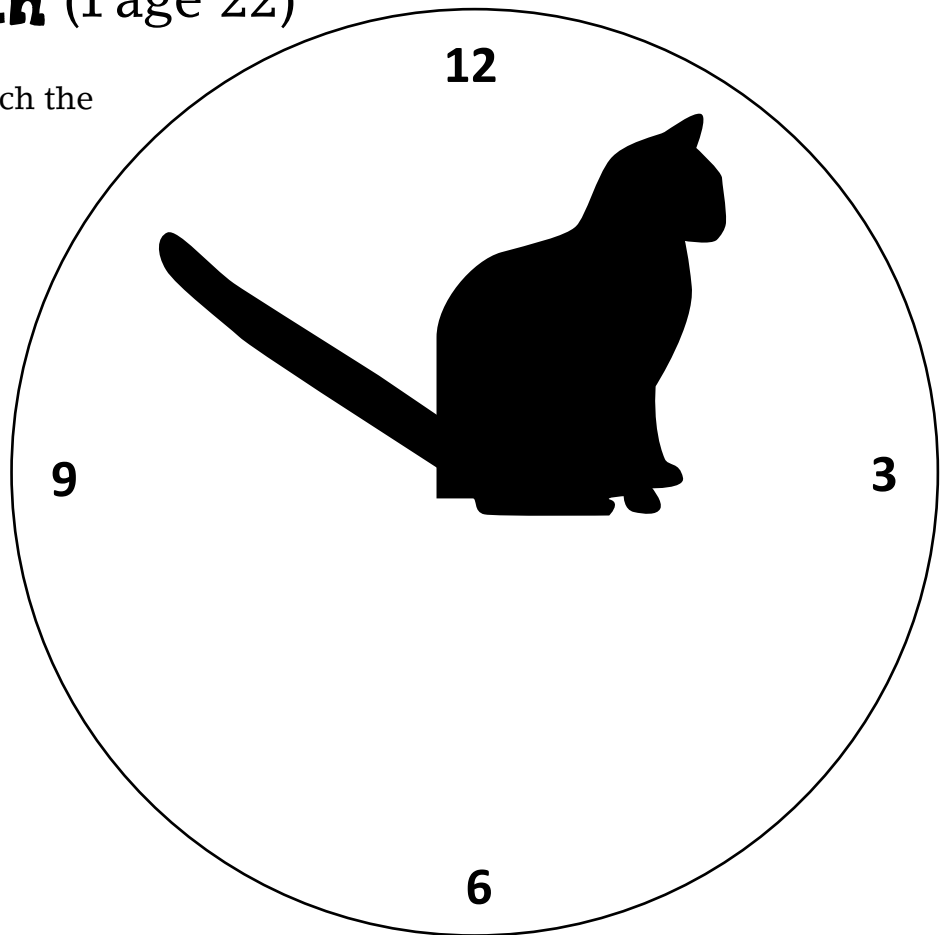
Easy Embroidery (Page 21)

Choose a template. Photocopy the image onto tracing paper, and trace onto embroidery canvas. Use a running stitch or over stitching to embroider your cat.



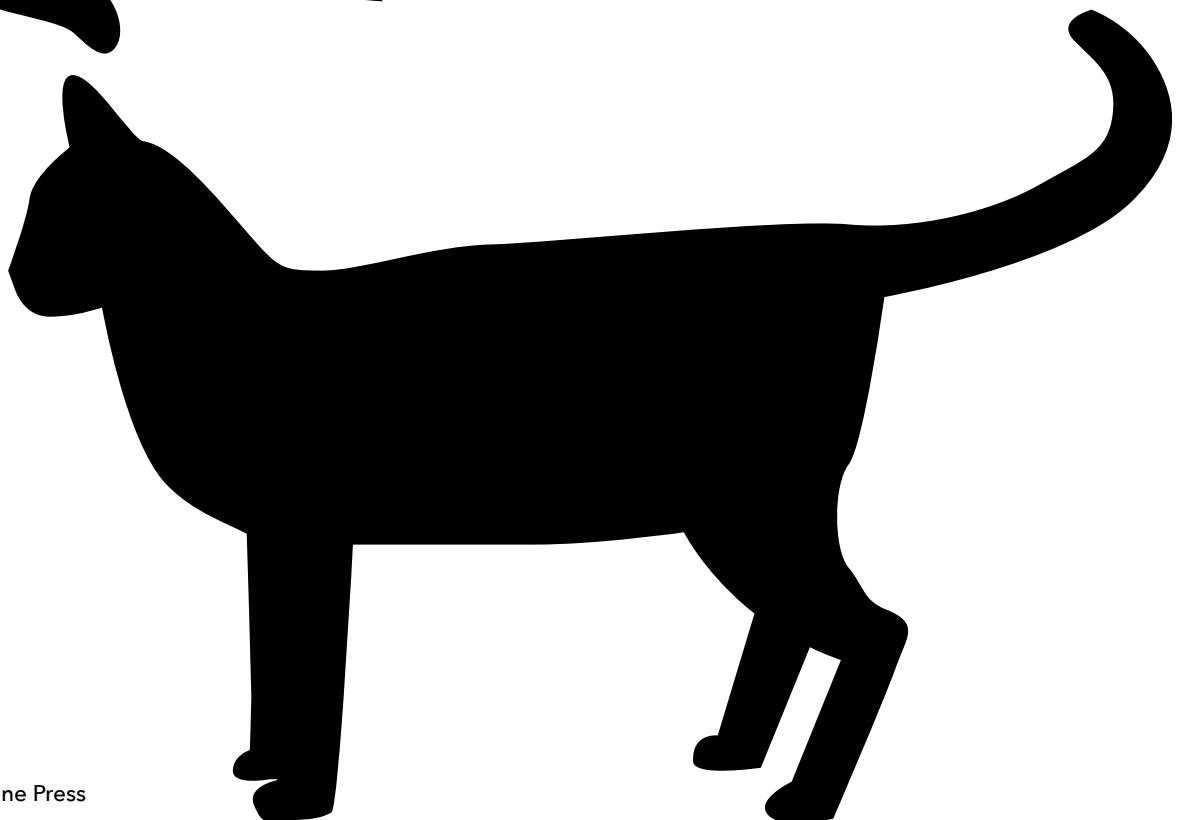
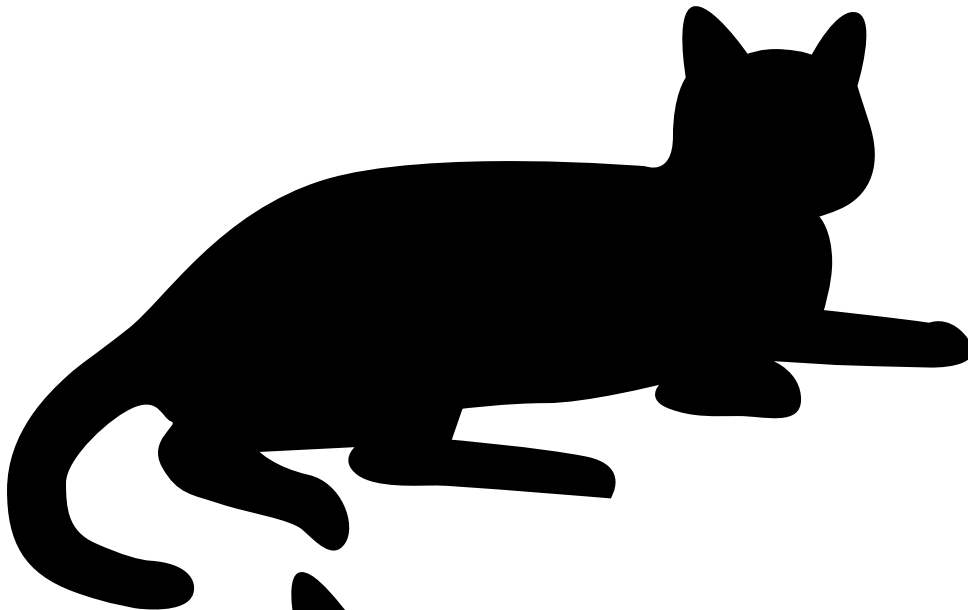
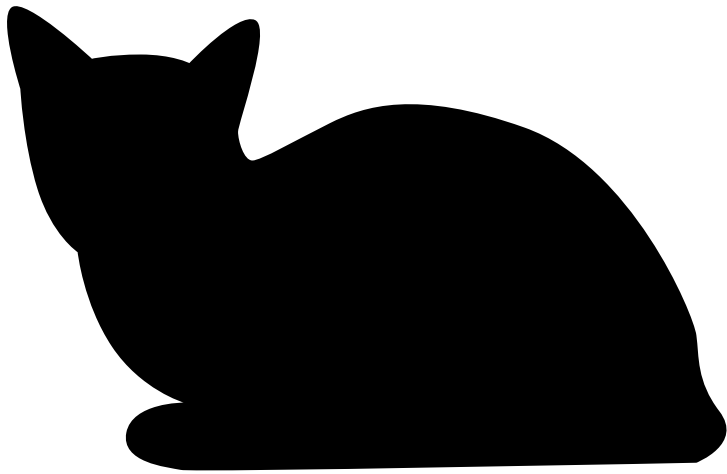
In a Tail Spin (Page 22)
